

At what height on a telecommunications tower is construction prohibited



Overview

A notification to the FAA is required, except as set forth in paragraph (e) of this section, for any of the following construction or alteration: (a) Any construction or alteration of more than 60. 96 meters (200 feet) in height above ground level at its site. (b) Any construction or alteration that. A new tower construction requires: NHPA (including Section 106). Antenna Structure Registration (ASR) with the FCC. See the Amended Collocation Agreement and other. The Enforcement Bureau's Field Offices investigate complaints regarding lighting outages, other deficient lighting and marking of antenna structures that can cause air hazards, and failures to comply with rules governing lighting monitoring, tower registration, and tower recordkeeping.
