Fabrication of Elbows

Elbows are used to change the direction of cable trays, commonly at 45° or 90° angles. The fabrication process involves:

- Precision Cutting: Use laser cutters or CNC punching machines to cut tray components accurately to the required dimensions and angles .
- Bending Techniques: Employ CNC bending machines or manual bending tools with mandrels to prevent kinking or collapsing of the metal, maintaining the tray's internal diameter .
- Assembly: Elbows are attached to the main tray using welding or bolting, ensuring firm connections to avoid instability .

Fabrication of Tees and Crosses

Tees and crosses allow multiple tray directions to intersect:

- Tees: Enable a T-shaped branch, splitting one tray into two. Fabrication requires precise alignment and welding or bolting to maintain structural integrity .
- Crosses: Facilitate four-way junctions for complex layouts. These require even more precise alignment during assembly to handle multiple connections
