Cable trays are used to support and route electrical conductors, including power, control, and communication circuits, in industrial and commercial facilities .

Key NEC Requirements for Cable Trays

- **Voltage Marking:** Cable trays containing conductors rated over 600 volts must be marked with "DANGER — HIGH VOLTAGE — KEEP AWAY" at intervals not exceeding 10 feet (3 meters) to warn personnel of electrical hazards . Labels must comply with NEC section 110.21(B) and ANSI Z535.4 standards for safety signs.
- **Cable Types:** Only conductors rated for open-air environments, such as Tray Rated (Type TC) or Metal-Clad (Type MC) cables, are permitted .
- **Clearances and Accessibility:** Maintain at least 12 inches of vertical clearance above trays for maintenance, and ensure trays remain accessible. They are prohibited in hoistways or enclosed spaces .
- **Fill Limits and Separation:** Power cables should not exceed 40% of the tray's cross-sectional area, and control cables 50%. High-power and low-power cables must be separated to prevent electromagnetic interference
