Purpose and Function

Types of Cable Trays

- Ladder Tray: Features side rails connected by rungs, ideal for heavy power cables and long spans. Provides excellent ventilation and heat dissipation .
- Solid Bottom Tray: Offers maximum protection from dust, moisture, and physical interference, often used for sensitive or fiber-optic cables .
- Ventilated/Trough Tray: Combines support and ventilation, allowing air circulation and some dust to fall through while supporting medium-weight cables .
- Wire Mesh Tray: Lightweight and flexible, allowing 360-degree access and easy m...
