

Configuration of Level 3 Active Distribution Box



Article Overview

A Level 3 active distribution box combines Layer 3 routing for network traffic with proper electrical distribution, requiring careful setup of VLANs, uplinks, trunk ports, and protective devices.

Network Configuration (Layer 3)

- Uplink Interface Setup: Begin by configuring the uplink interface to connect the distribution switch to the core network or firewall. Initialize the Layer 3 interface and assign an IP address distinct from the management interface to ensure proper routing and Internet access ().
- Inter-VLAN Routing: Configure Layer 3 interfaces for each VLAN (e.g., data and voice). Each interface should have a unique IP address serving as the default gateway for clients in that VLAN ().
- Trunk Ports: The port connecting to downstream access switches must be configured as a trunk to carry multiple VLANs. Ensure the uplink port on the access switch matches the trunk configuration to prevent VLAN mismatches ().
- Firewall Integration: If the distribution switch is the gateway for downstream subnets, configure static routes on the firewall to direct traffic to the appropriate VLAN interfaces on the switch ().
- Routing Protocols: For advanced setups like Cisco ACI, select a routing protocol (OSPF, BGP) and configure the L3Out domain, VRF, and BGP route reflectors to distribute external routes across the fabric ().
