

Configuration of Low-Voltage Fire Protection Distribution Box



Article Overview

A low-voltage fire protection distribution box combines fire-resistant enclosures with properly sized protective devices, surge protection, ventilation, and maintenance features to ensure safe and reliable operation.

Fire-Resistant Enclosure

The distribution box should be housed in a fire-resistant enclosure that meets standards such as DIN 4102 Part 2 (F30/F90) for interior and exterior fire resistance, ensuring functionality for at least 30-90 minutes during a fire . The enclosure should include automatic closure of ventilation openings in case of fire and be equipped with fireproof doors and locks to prevent fire spread .

Internal Configuration

Inside the box, the layout should allow for safe installation and separation of components:

- Circuit breakers for overload and short-circuit protection, sized according to load type (continuous, non-continuous, or motor loads) and service factors .
- Residual current devices (RCDs) to detect imbalances and prevent electric shock .
- Surge protective devices (SPDs) to limit voltage spikes and protect sensitive equipment, especially for critical circuits like fire pumps or emergency elevators .
- Fuses for additional overcurrent protection, melting when current exceeds safe li...
