Article Overview

Level 3 surge protection ensures sensitive equipment is fully protected from transient overvoltages within distribution boxes.

Overview of Level 3 Protection

Level 3 surge protection is the final barrier in a graded lightning protection system, designed to safeguard sensitive or critical electronic equipment from residual transient overvoltages that pass through upstream protection devices . It is typically installed inside the equipment or at the equipment's power supply input and complements Level 1 and Level 2 SPDs, which handle high-energy surges from direct or nearby lightning strikes .

Technical Requirements

- Maximum discharge current: 20 kA per phase or lower
- Voltage protection level (U_p): ≤ 1800 V
- Connection: Three-phase wires (A/B/C) connected to corresponding SPD terminals; the yellow-green ground wire must connect to the dedicated surge protection grounding terminal, not the general protective earth
- Purpose: Eliminate transient overvoltages to ensure long-term stable operation of sensitive equipment
