Fiber Transceivers and Switches: Fiber network adapters or SFP/SFP+ transceivers can be installed in compatible switches to allow direct fiber connections. This setup can connect fiber optic cables to your network panel indirectly through a switch, enabling high-speed fiber-to-Ethernet conversion and maintaining network performance .
