

Drilling parameters for cable tray supports



Article Overview

Drilling for cable tray supports requires selecting the correct hole size, spacing, and anchor type based on tray type, load, and mounting surface.

Key Considerations

1. Support Type and Material Cable trays can be ladder, ventilated trough, or solid-bottom types, typically made of steel, stainless steel, or aluminum . The support elements—wall brackets, suspended supports, or center suspensions—must be compatible with the tray material and the mounting surface to prevent corrosion and ensure mechanical stability . 2. Drill Hole Size The drill bit size depends on the anchor or fastener used. Common practice is to match the hole diameter to the anchor manufacturer's specifications. For example:

- Expansion anchors in concrete: drill slightly smaller than the anchor diameter to ensure a tight fit.
 - Threaded bolts in steel or wood: drill a pilot hole slightly smaller than the bolt diameter to allow threading or secure fastening .
3. Support Spacing Support spacing is critical to prevent sagging and maintain load capacity:
- Ladder trays: typically supported every 1.5 to 3 meters (5-10 feet) depending on tray width and cable load .
 - Solid-bottom trays: may require closer spacing due to reduced rigidity.
 - Wall-mounted brackets: spacing often ranges from 1.2 to 2 meters (4-6 feet) depending on cable weight and environmental conditions .
