Core Function of a Distribution Box

A distribution box, also known as a DB box or distribution board, is a central hub that receives electrical power from a main supply and distributes it to multiple secondary circuits in residential, commercial, or industrial settings . It ensures that electricity is delivered safely and efficiently while protecting circuits from overloads, short circuits, and electrical faults .

Key Components and Their Roles

- Circuit Breakers (MCBs): Automatically disconnect circuits during overloads or short circuits to prevent damage .
- Residual Current Devices (RCCBs/RCBOs): Detect leakage currents and protect against electric shocks .
- Isolators: Manually disconnect circuits for maintenance or emergency purposes .
- Bus Bars: Conduct electricity within the box and distribute power to multiple circuits .
- Neutral and Grounding Bars: Provide return paths and ensure safe grounding to prevent electrical hazards
