

How to splice cable tray elbows

Splice Plates for Elbows

Splice plates are flat metal plates with pre-drilled holes used to join two cable tray sections, including elbows, at angles. For L-shaped, T-shaped, or cross-shaped elbows, angled splice plates are used to maintain alignment and structural integrity. The plates are bolted to the tray sides using nuts and bolts, providing a strong mechanical connection suitable for heavy cable loads and long-term stability .

Bolted Connections

Bolted connections are the most common method for securing elbow joints. After positioning the elbow section, nuts and bolts are inserted through the tray and splice plate holes. Proper torque control is critical to prevent loosening due to vibration and to maintain system stability. This method allows for disassembly if future modifications or maintenance are required .

Quick Connect Systems

Quick connect systems are designed for faster installation. These systems snap, slide, or twist together with minimal tools, making them ideal for large projects or when multiple elbows need to be installed quickly. While they reduce labor time by 30-50...
