

How to split a fiber optic cable into three routers

How Fiber Splitting Works

A fiber optic splitter is a passive device that divides a single incoming optical signal into multiple outputs, allowing one fiber to serve multiple devices or endpoints . Common splitter configurations include 1×2, 1×4, and 1×8, meaning one input can be split into 2, 4, or 8 outputs, respectively . For connecting three routers, a 1×4 splitter would be suitable, providing three outputs for the routers and leaving one port spare.

Methods of Splitting

- **Passive Splitting:** Uses a dedicated optical splitter to divide the light signal without requiring power. This is ideal for short distances or local networks, such as connecting multiple routers in an office or home .
- **Active Splitting:** Uses devices like optical switches or add-drop multiplexers that can amplify and manage the signal. This is more common in long-haul or telecom networks but is generally unnecessary for small setups .
