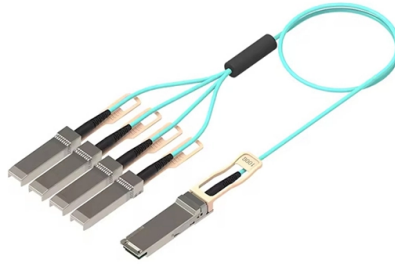


Installation Method of Vertical Cable Tray Support

Vertical cable tray supports are installed using wall-mounted brackets, cantilever arms, or trapeze hangers, ensuring proper load distribution, spacing, and compliance with NEC and NEMA standards.

Key Considerations

Load and Span Calculations: Determine the total anticipated weight of cables and the tray itself. Support spacing must follow manufacturer load charts and NEMA VE 1 standards to prevent sagging or structural failure . Overfilling trays can lead to overheating and damage, so proper cable fill calculations per NEC 392.22 are essential . **Material Selection:** Choose materials suitable for the environment. Steel, stainless steel, or aluminum are common, with corrosion-resistant finishes for industrial or outdoor applications . Stainless steel (AISI 316L) is preferred in highly corrosive environments .

Support Methods for Vertical Runs

Cantilever Wall Brackets: These are mounted directly to walls and are ideal for vertical cable tray runs. Brackets must be securely anchored to structural elements and sized to handle the tray load . **Trapeze Hangers:** While typically used for ceiling suspensions, trapeze hangers can be adapted for vertical applications where multiple trays are supported in parallel. They provide even load distribution and allow for adjustments during installation . **Channel Support Systems:** For heavy or complex in...
