- **Splicing:** Fusion or mechanical splicing connects incoming fibers to pigtails. Splice trays protect these splices and maintain proper bend radius to prevent signal loss .
- **Termination:** Fibers are terminated into connectors (LC, SC, ST, or MPO/MTP) on patch panels. This allows active equipment to connect via patch cords. Modular patch panels are recommended for scalable expansion .
- **Patching and Distribution:** Patch cords cross-connect terminated fibers, enabling flexible routing from the ODF to transceivers or distribution points. This step allows...
