

Relay protection anti-pumping test

An anti-pumping test verifies that a circuit breaker closes only once per close command, preventing repeated closing (pumping) that can damage equipment.

What is an Anti-Pumping Relay?

An anti-pumping relay is a protective device installed in a circuit breaker's closing circuit to prevent repeated closing attempts, known as pumping or hunting, which occur when a close command persists while a fault exists in the system . Pumping can cause severe mechanical stress on the breaker, arcing damage to contacts, overheating of the closing coil, and potential damage to connected equipment like transformers and cables . The relay ensures that one close command produces only one close operation, even if the close signal remains active .

How the Anti-Pumping Relay Works

The relay monitors the breaker's position and interrupts the closing circuit after a single close-open operation until the close command is removed and reapplied . The typical operation sequence is:

- Close Signal Applied: The operator presses the close button or moves the TNC switch to "close," energizing the closing coil. The breaker closes successfully .
- Trip Occurs: If a fault is detected, the protection relay trips the breaker open.
- Blocking Further Closes: The anti-pumping relay prevents the breaker from closing again until the close button is released and pressed again, effectively breaking the continuous close signal . The relay may use normally closed (NC) contacts in series with the closing coil, which open after the first operation to block further closing sig...
