Router optical module ports, such as SFP and SFP+, allow routers to connect to fiber or high-speed Ethernet networks using hot-pluggable transceivers.

Overview of Optical Module Ports

Optical module ports on routers, commonly SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable), SFP+, and SFP28, are compact, hot-swappable interfaces that convert electrical signals from the router into optical signals for fiber connections, or vice versa, enabling high-speed data transmission over long distances . These ports are widely used in enterprise networks, data centers, and carrier-grade deployments to ensure reliable connectivity .

Types of Modules

- SFP (1–4 Gbps) – Suitable for standard Gigabit Ethernet or Fiber Channel connections.
- SFP+ (up to 10 Gbps) – Commonly used for 10G Ethernet and high-speed fiber networks, offering flexibility and scalability .
- SFP28 (25 Gbps) – Designed for 25G Ethernet applications, often in modern data centers . Modules can be optical (for fiber) or copper (RJ45), and they adhere to Multi-Source Agreements (MSA), ensuring physical compatibility across different vendors, though electrical and optical compatibility must be verified to avoid link failures .
