

Technical Requirements for Optical Cable Laying in Conduit



Article Overview

Optical fiber cables must be installed in conduits following strict guidelines for conduit preparation, cable tension, bend radius, lubrication, and safety to ensure long-term performance and compliance with industry standards.

Conduit Preparation and Installation

Fiber optic cables are typically installed in preinstalled conduits that run between access points such as manholes or hand holes. Conduits should be as straight as possible, and existing conduits must be cleaned and inspected before installation. Burrs and obstructions should be removed using a plug, wire brush, and swab to prevent abrasion damage to the cable jacket during pulling. Underground conduits are usually buried 1–1.2 meters deep, with conductive marker tape placed above dielectric conduits for future detection. Aerial conduits can be used to protect cables from environmental hazards and reduce costs in certain crossings.

Cable Handling and Pulling

Fiber optic cables must not be subjected to excessive twist, which can increase attenuation. A breakaway swivel should be used to attach the pull rope to the cable to prevent twisting. Maximum pulling tension varies by cable type; for example, stranded loose tube and ribbon cables typically have a maximum pulling tension of 600 lbf (2,700 N). Proper cable lubrication reduces friction and tension during pulling, with water-based lubricants recommended for most cable jackets
