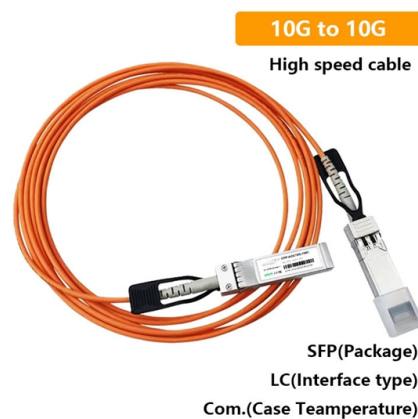


Various bridge structures in the Middle East

The Middle East features a diverse range of bridge structures, including sea causeways, cable-stayed bridges, suspension bridges, and urban highway bridges, reflecting both engineering innovation and regional development priorities.

Notable Sea Bridges and Causeways

- Sheikh Jaber Al-Ahmad Al-Sabah Causeway, Kuwait: Completed in 2019, this is the fourth longest sea bridge in the world, spanning almost 49 kilometers with 36 kilometers over water. It connects Kuwait City to the Silk City megadevelopment and includes the 12.4-kilometer Doha Link. The causeway features dual 17-meter-wide carriageways with three traffic lanes each, emergency lanes, and artificial islands supporting the structure. It significantly reduces travel time across Kuwait's coastal roads and incorporates advanced traffic monitoring systems .

UAE Bridges: The United Arab Emirates hosts numerous significant bridges, including the Maqta Bridge, Bridge of Tolerance, Dubai Water Canal Footbridge III, Safa Bridge, Sixth Dubai Creek Bridge, and Sheikh Zayed Bridge. These bridges serve both road and rail traffic, with spans exceeding 100 meters or total lengths over 5 kilometers, integrating modern design with urban infrastructure
