

# What cable should be plugged into the optical port of the switch

Fiber optic cables, typically with LC or SC connectors, are used for the optical (SFP) ports of a switch.

### Understanding Optical Ports

Optical ports on switches are usually SFP (Small Form-Factor Pluggable) or SFP+ ports, which are modular interfaces that accept transceiver modules. These ports do not directly determine the cable type; instead, the SFP module inserted into the port defines the connection medium—either fiber or copper . Optical SFP modules are designed to transmit data over fiber optic cables, enabling long-distance and high-speed connections .

### Types of Fiber Cables

The fiber optic cables used with SFP ports are called fiber patch cables or fiber jumpers. They come in different types depending on distance and application:

- Single-mode fiber (SMF): Typically yellow, used for long-distance links (up to tens of kilometers) with low signal loss .
- Multimode fiber (MMF): Usually orange (OM1/OM2) or aqua (OM3/OM4), used for shorter distances within data centers or buildings, generally up to 500 meters at high speeds ....
