An optical cable, also known as a fiber-optic cable, consists of a central core made of ultra-pure glass or plastic that carries light signals, surrounded by a cladding layer with a slightly different refractive index to keep the light contained through total internal reflection. Protective layers, including a buffer coating and an outer jacket, shield the fibers from physical damage, moisture, and environmental stress, while some cables include additional armor for outdoor or undersea use .

### How It Works

Data is transmitted as pulses of light generated by LEDs or lasers. The light travels through the core, reflecting off the cladding walls without escaping, allowing signals to cover long distances with minimal loss and high resistance to electromagnetic interference. This makes optical cables faster and more reliable than traditional copper cables, capable of handling speeds from tens of gigabits per second to experimental rates exceeding one petabit per second .
