

What does terminal box 8a2 mean

Terminal box 8A2 typically refers to a specific connection point on a Tina 8A connection block or a DIN-style terminal designation, used for wiring safety or electrical circuits.

Tina 8A Connection Block Context

The Tina 8A is a connection block manufactured by ABB, designed for safety circuits in industrial automation. It features eight M12 5-pole connectors, allowing multiple safety devices to connect to a safety controller or safety PLC through a single cable, reducing wiring complexity and cost (ABB) . Each connector or terminal on the block is numbered, and unused connectors are covered with Tina 1A blanking plugs to maintain safety compliance. In this context, 8A2 could indicate the second terminal or connector on the 8A block, used for connecting a specific safety device or input/output line.

Installation and Usage

- Attach the Tina 8A block to a surface using M4 bolts.
- Connect wires to the numbered terminals (1-13) on the block.
- Connect safety devices to the M12 connectors, and cover unused connectors with Tina 1A plugs.
- Test all safety functions after installation to ensure proper operation (ABB) .
