General Structure

A pigtail connector is essentially a short cable assembly where one end is pre-terminated with a connector (such as a spade, ring, or fiber optic connector) and the other end consists of bare or stripped wires ready for splicing, soldering, or crimping into a system . - **Wire Gauge and Insulation:** The wire thickness (AWG) and insulation type vary according to current capacity and environmental requirements. Insulation color often indicates function, such as green for ground wires in household systems .
- **Bare Wire End:** The un-terminated end is stripped and may be twisted, tinned, or crimped depending on the intended connection
