

What is the spacing between 800 cable tray supports



Article Overview

For an 800 mm wide cable tray, support spacing typically ranges from 1.5 to 3 meters depending on load, cable type, and tray design, with rung spacing of 6–12 inches recommended for proper cable support.

Support Span

The support span is the distance between structural supports for the cable tray. For wide trays such as 800 mm, the span should generally be shorter than for narrower trays to maintain structural integrity. Typical support intervals are:

- 1.5 to 2 meters for heavily loaded trays or large power cables
 - 2 to 3 meters for lighter loads or small-diameter control and instrumentation cables
- Longer spans may require stronger rungs or additional reinforcement to prevent sagging and maintain safety .

Rung Spacing

Rung spacing is critical to prevent cable drooping and ensure proper load distribution:

- 6–9 inches (150–230 mm) for small-diameter control and instrumentation cables
 - 9–12 inches (230–300 mm) for larger power cables
- Wider rung spacing reduces tray strength, so for an 800 mm tray, closer rung spacing is recommended to support the wider cable load
