

Where are the fiber optic cables spliced in Costa Rica

Costa Rica's fiber optic cables are primarily spliced and landed at Limón on the Caribbean coast and Esterillos, Puntarenas on the Pacific coast, connecting international submarine cables to domestic networks.

Key International Landing Points

- **Limón (Caribbean Coast):** This is the landing site for several major submarine cables, including MAYA-1, AMX-1, and ARCOS-1. Limón serves as a critical hub for connecting Costa Rica to the United States, Mexico, Colombia, and other Caribbean nations, providing redundancy and high-speed international connectivity .
- **Esterillos, Puntarenas (Pacific Coast):** The Pan American Crossing (PAC) cable lands here, offering an alternative route to the Caribbean-based cables. This Pacific landing point is strategically important for connecting Costa Rica to Asian markets and enhancing network redundancy .
- **TAM-1 Cable:** Scheduled to be operational by late 2025, TAM-1 will integrate with Costa Rica's domestic network, landing along the Atlantic coast and connecting the country to the United States and South America. This next-generation system will support 24 fiber pairs and high-capacity transmission, further strengthening Costa Rica's international connectivity .
