

Why is drop fiber optic cable called butterfly fiber optic cable

Drop fiber optic cables are called butterfly cables because their flat, wing-shaped cross-section resembles a butterfly, with the optical fiber in the center and two parallel strength members on either side.

Design and Structure

The term "butterfly" comes from the cable's cross-sectional shape: it has a flat, wing-like profile with the optical fiber unit positioned in the center and two parallel reinforcing members flanking it on both sides. This design gives the cable a distinctive appearance similar to a butterfly's wings, which is why the name is used.

Functional Advantages

- **Directional Bending:** The flat shape allows the cable to bend easily in the flat plane, which is ideal for routing along walls, ceilings, or around door frames, while resisting sharp kinks when bent edge-on.
- **Strength and Durability:** The parallel strength members, typically made of Fiber Reinforced Plastic (FRP) or steel wire for outdoor versions, provide tensile strength and resistance to lateral pressure.
- **Bend-Insensitive Fiber:** Butterfly cables usually use bend-insensitive single-mode fibers (ITU-T G.657 standard), which tolerate tight bend radii without significant signal loss.
- **Lightweight and Flexible:** The flat design reduces weight and makes installation easier, especially in indoor FTTH applications.
